Motion: Mr. Iaboni moved, Mr. Moore seconded and the motion carried 3-0 to approve the October 16, 2014 Agenda. Ms. Joy was not present for the vote.

2. APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES

Motion: Mr. Iaboni moved, Mr. Moore seconded and the motion carried 3-0 to approve the September 18, 2014 minutes. Ms. Joy was not present for the vote.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

No members of the public were present.

4. CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT CU 2014-03 (R.LAYTON)

THIS IS A REQUEST FOR A CONDITONAL USE PERMIT CU 2014-03 BY PET'S LIFE NATURALLY LOCATED AT $523~8^{\rm TH}$ AVENUE WEST; PET'S LIFE NATURALLY IS PROPSING AN ELECTRONIC SIGN.

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Ms. Layton stated that Pet's Life naturally is proposing an electronic sign to replace their existing sign, located at 523 8th Avenue West. Pet's Life Naturally is zoned CC (Commercial Core) and the Midtown District of the Downtown Design Guidelines. Ms. Layton also stated that there are three existing electronic signs within the Downtown Design Guidelines districts with Conditional Use Permits. According to the City's Code of Ordinances a Conditional Use Permit may be issued for an electronic sign.

Ms. Layton and staff recommend approval with conditions:

- 1. Brightness shall not exceed 5000 lumens in the daytime and 1500 lumens at nighttime
- 2. Changeable copy display shall not change more than once every fifteen (15) seconds.
- 3. The sign shall be in substantial conformance with the rendering presented at the hearing.
- 4. No sound shall be emitted from the sign.

Jack May and Park Crisp were present on behalf of Magee Signs and stated that they will be reusing the support structure but the face and the fluorescent cabinet will be new.

Mr. May stated the new sign should not be a distraction to the public.

Leo Mills, Palmetto resident stated he is for the sign and welcomed it.

The Board had concerns with increasing the size of the sign by such a small amount.

Mr. Iaboni asked if coordination could be made to intertwine the change of the sign and the change of the traffic light at the corner of 7th Street West and 8th Avenue West. Mr. May stated that arrangement could be made.

Mr. May stated that they would also make the change to the size of the sign so will to be in accordance of the City's Ordinances.

Attorney Rudacille exited the meeting at 6:05 p.m. and returned at 6:06 p.m.

Board's approval with modifications: Changeable copy display shall change in coordination with green traffic light at 7th Street West and 8th Avenue West. Signature surface area shall not exceed 40 sq. ft.

Motion: Ms. Joy moved, Mr. Moore seconded and the motion carried 4-0 to approve the CU 2014-13.
