3. CRA CONSENT AGENDA

- A. Brownfields Site Rehabilitation Agreement (Edenfield)
- B. MLK Park Conservation Easement to SWFWMD

Mr. Burton explained that the Brownfields Site Rehabilitation Agreement is an agreement with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) for the former Edenfield Property. It is a voluntary cleanup program that will allow the City to apply for grants and tax credits.

4A Palmetto Riverside Boat Ramp Pavilion Conceptual

Mr. Burton informed the Board that the conceptual drawing that was presented at the workshop today was approved by the CRA Advisory Board earlier this month. He is asking the Board approve what was presented at the workshop with the addition of more restrooms for the public. This will ensure the project starts moving along.

Mrs. Varnadore does not agree with the addition of this item to the agenda due to the lack of advertisement to the public regarding such. Mrs. Cornwell agreed with Mrs. Varnadore; however, she opined that because it is a conceptual plan that is why she agreed to have it put on the agenda. Motion: Mrs. Cornwell moved, Mr. Davis seconded, and the motion carried 3-2 to approve the bus stop conceptual. Mr. Williams and Mrs. Varnadore voted no.
