If you are found to be in violation, a fine may be assessed against you, as provided by law. The purpose of the hearing shall be to conduct proceedings regarding the attached Notice of Violation attached hereto as Exhibit A.

If you desire to appeal any decision of the CEB with respect to any matter considered at this Public Hearing, you will need a verbatim record of the proceedings and for that purpose, you need to insure that a verbatim record is made which includes the testimony, and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based. The hearing may be continued from time to time as deemed warranted and appropriate by the CEB. This case may be presented to the CEB even if the violation or repeat violation has been corrected prior to the hearing.

The purpose of this letter is to provide you with notice that based upon investigation of alleged violations of the City Code, and upon inspection by the undersigned, it has been determined that a violation of the City Code is occurring at the above-referenced property. THIS IS NOTICE that a failure to accomplish corrective action and remedy the violations above within the time provided will result in referral of this matter to the City's Code Enforcement Board for a hearing. If, after the hearing by the Code Enforcement Board, violations are determined, such violations may be punishable by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) per day for a first violation and a fine not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) per day for a repeat violation, in addition to and including, all costs incurred by the City as a result of such enforcement action.

Eric Pardo and Eloyna Valerio, 2702 12th Street West, Palmetto, Florida:

The property that is the subject of this code enforcement action is located at 2702 12th Street West, Palmetto, Florida, Parcel ID # 28184.0002/6

The Respondents, Eric Pardo and Eloyna Valerio, are identified as the owners of this property through the Manatee County Property Appraiser's and Manatee County Tax Collector's web sites.

On October 17, 2007 I received an anonymous complaint that the Respondents had erected a solid vinyl fence on the west side of their property without a building permit. During my site inspection on the same date I observed a new solid vinyl fence on the west border of the subject property, and I spoke to the resident who acknowledged that they had recently erected this fence. She further stated she was unaware of the requirement for a building permit. I provided the telephone number for the Building Department, and I directed the resident to secure a fence permit or dismantle the fence. A Cease and Desist order was not issued as the construction activity was finished at the time of my visit. The Building Department was advised of the action I took on October 27, 2007.

I monitored the residence for compliance through November 29, 2007; the Building Department also confirmed that a fence permit had not been issued for this address. Building Department staff did state that a woman had been there several times attempting to secure a permit, but the Department could not issue it as the individual was a renter, not the owner. On December 3, 2007 a Notice of Violation was forwarded to the Respondents directing them to obtain a permit within five days of receipt of this Notice. The property continued to be in violation of City codes – the fence remained and a valid permit had not been obtained – and a Notice of Hearing was forwarded to the Respondents on January 2, 2008, scheduling this case before the Code Enforcement Board on January 22, 2008. Both sets of notices were forwarded certified and regular mail. The certified copy of the Notice of Violation was returned by the US Postal Service as unclaimed; the Respondents received notices of the certified mail by the Post Office on December 4 and December 10, 2007. (*Proofs of Service of the Notice of Violation and the Notice of Hearing are submitted for the record.*)

Recommendation:

It is recommended the Respondents be found in violation of City of Palmetto Code of Ordinances, and that Eric Pardo and Eloyna Valerio be directed to secure the requisite building permit within ten (10) days of this hearing. It is further recommended that the City's administrative costs for prosecuting this case, plus any applicable recording fees, be assessed against the respondents at this time.
