Property Damage Release

MANATEE COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE Office of the County Attorney

PROBLEM:

The City of Palmetto owes Baker's Paint & Body Shop (\$1,022.75) for the repairs completed to a PPD vehicle.

BACKGROUND:

Currently the COP owes Baker's Paint & Body Shop, \$1,022.75 for the repairs completed to PPD vehicle # 643 due to an accident occurring on 12/18/2008, when a Manatee County Sheriff's deputy backed-out of his parking space into the PPD vehicle, who was driving by in the appropriate lane. The impact caused damage to both vehicles. The Sheriff's deputy was found at-fault for the accident, making the Sheriff's office liable for the damages. In order to seek reimbursement for the cost to repair, the COP must initiate a property damage claim with the Office of the County Attorney. Having completed the claims process, and in order to finalize the reimbursement action, the Office of the County Attorney is asking for a signed Property Damage Release from the City of Palmetto. The PPD officer was not injured according to the report. Staff has not identified any other costs associated with this incident, except for the vehicle repair.

ALTERNATIVES:

1. – Take No Action and continue to hold the accounts payable to Baker's Paint & Body Shop.
2. – Enter into an agreement with the County Attorney's Office to initiate payment directly to Baker's Paint & Body Shop.
- 3 – Sign-Off on the Property Damage Release Form to expedite reimbursement from Manatee County Government.
- 4 – Initiate COP payment to Baker's Paint & Body Shop, while seeking reimbursement from Manatee County.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends Alternative # 4.
