ORDINANCE 09-992 REVISE THE PURCHASING POLICY TO CLARIFY THE PROPERTY PROCEDURES; APPLY TO TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY

May 4, 2009

BACKGROUND: As part of the review of the City Ordinances related to the relocation and construction of New Palmetto Elementary School, it was discovered that while the excess property provisions of the City Code appear to be intended to apply to tangible personal property that this was written in such a way that it could be interpreted to apply to all city property. State law does not require the restrictions of this section. With the proposed revisions to Section 2-64 of the Palmetto City Code, real property may be approved for conveyance by City Commission if the conveyance is in the best interest of the City.

DISCUSSION: The revision will clarify that Section 2-64 of the Code applies to Tangible Personal Property.

RECOMMENDATION: Authorize public hearing and publication notice for Ordinance 09-992.
