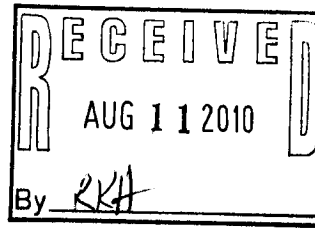

# INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT

## Family Resources - Manatee and Palmetto Police Department

### PURPOSE:

This agreement has been developed between **Family Resources - Manatee** and **Palmetto Police Department** to ensure viable services for families participating in the Supervised Visitation/Monitored Exchange Programs at **Family Resources - Manatee**.

### STATEMENT OF AGREEMENT:

**Family Resources - Manatee** agrees to:

- ◆ provide services to facilitate non-custodial parent access to and visitation or exchange of their children.
- ◆ provide a safe, supervised therapeutic environment for children and youth to meet or be exchanged with non-custodial parents.
- ◆ accept and refer clients without regard to race, sex, sexual preference, economic status, color, creed, religion, national origin, or physical handicap.
- ◆ accept referrals from **Palmetto Police Department**.
- ◆ exchange appropriate client information with **Palmetto Police Department** and be available to attend client staffing and hearings regarding participants in the Supervised Visitation/Monitored Exchange Program.

**Palmetto Police Department** agrees to:

- ◆ make appropriate Supervised Visitation/Monitored Exchange referrals to **Family Resources - Manatee**.
- ◆ exchange appropriate client information with **Family Resources - Manatee** to ensure proper coordination of services.
- ◆ refer clients without regard to race, sex, sexual preference, economic status, color, creed, religion, national origin, or physical handicap.

This agreement is entered into by both parties for the stated purpose of providing services to youth and families in Manatee County and may be revised by mutual agreement of both parties. This agreement, upon the stated need of either party, may be renegotiated at the end of the year.

# INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT

## **Family Resources - Manatee and Palmetto Police Department**

### PURPOSE:

This agreement has been developed between **Family Resources - Manatee** and **Palmetto Police Department** to provide a consistent process for serving Manatee County Children in Need of Services/Families in Need of Services (CINS/FINS) youth and families who are in crisis and in need of special assistance to meet their unique needs.

This agreement is to facilitate and encourage the strengthening of staff relations and enhanced communication in order to better serve youth in need of the above agencies' services.

### STATEMENT OF AGREEMENT:

**Family Resources - Manatee** agrees to:

- ◆ provide services to runaway, truant, and ungovernable youth and their families in Manatee County in order to build individual and family unity and strength.
- ◆ refer appropriate youth and families to **Palmetto Police Department** in order that they may benefit from **Palmetto Police Department** specialized services.
- ◆ maintain regular contacts with **Palmetto Police Department**, to ensure proper coordination of services.
- ◆ refer clients without regard to race, sex, sexual preference, economic status, color, creed, religion, national origin, or physical handicap.
- ◆ accept referrals from **Palmetto Police Department**.

**Palmetto Police Department** agrees to:

- ◆ accept appropriate referrals from **Family Resources - Manatee**.
- ◆ make appropriate referrals to **Family Resources - Manatee**.
- ◆ maintain regular contacts with **Family Resources - Manatee** to ensure proper coordination of services.
- ◆ refer clients without regard to race, sex, sexual preference, economic status, color, creed, religion, national origin, or physical handicap.
