Florida Recreation Development Assistance Program (FRDAP) a competitive grant program provides financial assistance to local governments for development or acquisition of land for public outdoor recreational purposes. All county governments and municipalities in Florida and other legally constituted local governmental entities with the legal responsibility for the provision of outdoor recreational sites and facilities for the use and benefit of the public are eligible. The maximum grant request may not exceed \$200,000.

FRDAP Grant Application submission period is September 15 through September 30, 2010.
