Amendment to Notice Requirements

Background: The Code of Ordinance in at least two locations requires fifteen days notice for certain ordinance adoption to be published and, in some cases, mailed to adjacent property owners and posted on the property. For other ordinances, only ten days notice is required.

Discussion: In 1995, Chapter 166 of the Florida Statutes was amended to allow for notice of only ten days. To reduce confusion, it is recommended that the Palmetto Code of Ordinances be amended to conform with the minimum requirements of the Florida Statutes. This matter has also been placed on the February 1, 2010 meeting agenda for initiation of the amendment.
