2011-29 DNA Lab Invoice

Since early 2010, the Palmetto Police Department has been combating a dramatic increase in property crimes. Effective pro-active strategies and successful criminal investigations have resulted in an impressive decrease in Part I Crimes and several felony arrests. The investigation of these crimes has required some extraordinary investigative resources, including DNA forensic services. Because of the volume of evidence and time constraints, the Department has utilized an approved private lab for these DNA forensics.

The lab, DNA International, has recently billed the Department for the two invoices relating to DNA forensic services (armed robbery 11-06590 and residential burglary 10-22710). The total amount due from these two invoices is \$24,620.00. Payment from these invoices will come from the Special Investigative Account 001-521-3521 in the amount of \$9,181. The balance of \$15,439 will come from the Reserves for Law Enforcement. As per F.S. 932.7055 (5)(a), DNA testing is considered a complex investigation expense and funds from the Reserves for Law Enforcement can be used to offset the cost but must be approved by City Commission.

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-29

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PALMETTO, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2010-29, WHICH RESOLUTION ADOPTED THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010-2011, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, from time to time it is necessary to increase or decrease revenues and expenditures in certain accounts, and;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide budgetary authorization for the expenditure of these funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PALMETTO, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That Revenue Account 001 381 7525, Law Enforcement Reserve, for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2011 is increased by Fifteen Thousand Four Hundred and Thirty-Nine dollars (\$15,439) to provide funding DNA International Invoice.

Section 2: That Expense Account 001 521 5225, Spec Fund – Operating Supplies, for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2011 is increased by Fifteen Thousand Four Hundred and Thirty-Nine dollars (\$15,439) to provide funding DNA International Invoice.

Section 3: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.

Section 4: All Resolutions and parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith are repealed.
