2012 Surplus Police Vehicle Auction

The following vehicles are no longer serviceable or have outlived their usefulness. The vehicles in question are:

- 1991 Nissan Pick-up 1N6SD11S4PC333262 (88,000 miles) Asset # 12573
- 1998 Ford Expedition 1FMRU17L0XLA84312 (144,000 miles) Asset # 16672
- 2001 Ford Crown Victoria 2FAFP71W01X136168 (96,000 miles) Asset # 16979
- 2004 Dodge Intrepid 2B3HD46V64H701677 (61,000 miles) Asset # 17307
- 2005 Chevrolet Impala 2G1WF52E259303432 (116,000 miles) Asset # 17413
- 2005 Chevrolet Impala 2G1WF52E559304509 (89,000 miles) Asset # 17414

All of these vehicles still have value on the used car market. Each of these vehicles has been stripped of its police equipment and de-striped. The police department recommends consigning all of these vehicles to the Tampa Machinery Auction, Incorporated, for public auction (with the vehicle sale proceeds returning to the City General Fund, per state statute). Since the Tampa Machinery Auction is a large, well publicized event that is held regularly, these vehicles can be sold quickly and their value returned to the City in a timely manner. Over the past two years, the Department has auctioned multiple vehicles through Tampa Machinery Auction and we are impressed with the quick turn-around and the returns that we receive on our surplus vehicles.

Once the vehicle have been auctioned, I propose that the City use the proceeds to continue re-striping our patrol fleet with our new graphics design and supplementing the Department's fuel budget.
