Mayor Bustle called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. on board the trolley.

Code Enforcement Director Bill Strollo narrated the tour. He discussed action taken to correct code enforcement issues such as homeless camp sites, criminal activities, improper open storage, improper construction sites, abandoned vehicles and demolished unsafe buildings. The tour also visited developments underway in the City; Riviera Dunes' Laguna, North Shore, Bel Mare and Hammocks projects; the new projects breaking ground at Palms of Terra Ceia; and Jupiter Marine in the Palmetto Industrial Park.

Mayor Bustle discussed the City's participation with FDOT to construct a divider on 10th Street to return 7th Avenue to a two-way street. Once the divider is completed traffic on 7th Avenue will enter and exit only by right turns.
